## U.S. government recognizes Securitas for climate leadership

**Securitas, a security solutions partner with world-leading technology and expertise, has been recognized as one of the top climate leaders among the U.S. government's largest 200 suppliers.**

To achieve net-zero emissions from procurement by 2050, the U.S. has launched a [supplier action leaderboard](#) highlighting exceptional climate leadership, which includes Securitas. As one of only 40 suppliers to meet all four climate action benchmarks – disclosing greenhouse gas emissions, setting science-based emissions-reduction targets, disclosing climate-related financial risk, and publishing a climate transition plan – Securitas is leading by example on climate action.

“I’m incredibly proud of the work we’re doing to build a safer and more sustainable world,” says President and CEO Magnus Ahlqvist. “As a global organization operating in 44 markets, we have a responsibility to lead by example – and we’re honored to be recognized for our efforts in this area. My hope is that our actions not only make an impact but also inspire others to join us in creating a future we can all be proud of.”

This recognition builds on Securitas’ ongoing commitment to sustainability. In December 2023, Securitas became the first global security solutions company to have its climate targets [validated](#) by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi). With this validation, Securitas commits to a substantial reduction of its emissions, taking action and responsibility in limiting global warming to 1.5°C.

Another industry-leading initiative – led by the Securitas Technology business – aims at promoting environmentally sustainable solutions in the electronic security sector. As part of the initiative, Securitas Technology now incorporates greenhouse gas emissions
